I'd like to thank you for the presentations you conducted at Smoky Hill High School during the 1993-1994 school year. Our students and faculty found your approach to be stimulating, informative and thought provoking. Our male students, in particular, left each session with a heightened awareness of their rights of passage and a very strong message that conflicts are not resolved by violence, and that violence is not a necessary part of manhood.
